Position Summary:

The Instructor teaches Basic Education classes that prepare students to enter a Home Health Aide (HHA) Certification Program. Students will learn the academics needed to enter a HHA Certification Program, but also will be prepared to become employed as a Home Health Aide. Instructor will collaborate with the Case Manager – HHA to assist students, place them in training, and follow-up on their employment status. The Instructor will report directly to the Director of Adult Education.

Responsibilities:

- Lead outreach and recruitment of HHA students.
- Teach basic literacy, test taking skills, job readiness and related health topics to prepare students to enter a Certified Home Health Aide Training.
- Create and implement a research-based curriculum.
- Take attendance daily. At minimum, maintain 15 students per session.
- Administer pre- and post-test TABE for all the students in the class.
- Collaborate with Case Manager to offer support and referrals to students in the program.
- Attend staff meetings and collaborate with Adult Education team to plan and design classes based on the learning needs of the students.
- Maintain communication with Adult Education Program Director about class activities and progress.
- Submit student attendance, in-take forms, and testing information to Case Manager to ensure timely input of student information into database by set deadlines.
- Additional duties as assigned by supervisor.

Qualifications:

• Associate's Degree in related field and two years experience teaching home health aides or job readiness.

- Home Health Aide Certification or related health certification.
- Experience working with urban adults and immigrants.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish)
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Excellent communication, organizational, verbal, and written skills.
- Excellent computer skills.
- Demonstrated ability to perform multiple tasks effectively in a fast-paced, challenging, and constantly changing environment.
