**Hours:** Full-Time, occasional weekend and/or overnight hours required

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Recruitment of participants and facilitation of intake.
- Provide college readiness workshops and identify opportunities for tutoring and completion of a rigorous curriculum.
- Design college success activities for high school students.
- Facilitate bi-weekly Leadership Academy workshops and community service activities for high school students.
- Assist Senior Counselor in planning and implementing Summer Writing and Theater program, and identifying internships.
- Assist with planning, implementation, and reporting of USCRP outcomes and partnership goals.
- Plan college trips for participants.
- Maintain program calendar, create flyers, and announcements.
- Create and facilitate youth development events, meetings, and activities for participants.
- Conduct individual and group college advisement sessions on financial aid and college admissions.
- Participate on at least one Youth Services programmatic committee.
- Additional duties as assigned by the Director of College Readiness and Director of Youth Services.

### **Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's Degree and a background in education, counseling, human services, the arts, or technology, with one year experience working in the area of college advisement, youth development and workshop presentations preferred.
- At minimum, a Bachelors Degree and three years experience working with youth populations, ages 12 to 21.

- Self- motivated, with the ability to work independently and make connections with young people from diverse backgrounds and cultures.
- Experience in all aspects of college admissions, financial aid, and scholarship processes.
- Demonstrated creativity in developing and implementing leadership and college prep workshops.
- Strong writing, public speaking, computer, and organizational skills.
- Ability to market the program, develop community partnerships, and provide innovative programming.
- Ability to work on the weekend (occasionally overnight) as needed.
- Candidates must complete successful background, criminal records, fingerprinting, and reference checks.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish or English/French) a plus.
