# **Position Summary:**

The Summer Science Activity Specialist will be responsible for the implementation of a curriculum that is intensive and challenges students to develop analytical and critical thinking skills in the science field. The Activity Specialist will design a lesson to increase student's science knowledge and ability in order to prepare students for high school level course work. Suggested science subjects include Earth Science, Biology, or Chemistry.

### **Additional Responsibilities:**

- Meet and instruct assigned classes at the time designated.
- Ensure a high quality, academic instructional program for students in Earth Science, Biology, or Chemistry.
- Encourage students to set and maintain standards of classroom behavior.
- Create a classroom environment conducive of learning.
- Take all necessary reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials and facilities.
- Attend staff meetings and trainings.
- Work cooperatively with staff, students and parents.
- Prepare for classes assigned, and show written evidence of preparation upon request of Program Coordinator.
- Coach students and work with students to prepare for final projects and participation on the portfolio committee.
- Mentor students and encourage possible college and career plans in science areas.
- Thorough completion and timely submission of all forms, including but not limited to; attendance sheets, incident and progress reports.
- Weekly review of student's progress with program coordinator.
- Fulfillment of other responsibilities as assigned by Program Director, Assistant Director and Director of Youth Services.

## **Qualifications:**

- Preferred: Bachelors in Science, Secondary Education or related math field.
- Minimum: Advanced/High performing undergraduate students with 60+ college credits in Science, Secondary Education or related Science field and a 3.0 GPA in Earth Science, Biology, or Chemistry coursework.
- Competency in all four STEM areas is a huge plus.
- Experience and/or interest in working with at risk middle school youth.
- Candidates must complete successful background, criminal records, fingerprinting, and reference checks.
- Confidence and creativity in teaching Earth Science, Biology, or Chemistry.
- Strong public speaking, computer, writing and organizational skills.
- Flexible, patient, with demonstrated ability to perform multiple activities effectively.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) a plus.
