Specific Responsibilities and Expectations:

- Manage daily operations of site, including supervising staff as needed.
- Address issues, concerns, and questions posed by staff, parents, and participants.
- Provide support, mentoring, and coaching to activity specialist.
- Pick-up participants from local schools and escort them to community center(s).
- Plan and implement weekly lesson plans related to activity including social, educational, and recreational.
- Produce mandated program reports, including attendance.
- Attend and escort youth on trips.
- Assist in classes, including classroom management and behavior modification.
- Participate in special events and staff meetings.
- Additional responsibilities as assigned by Program Coordinator, Assistant Director, and Director of Youth Services.
