Position: Photos and Me Program (PMP) Teacher

Department: Youth Services

Reports to: Literacy Programs Director **Hours:** Part-Time, 5 hours per week

3 hour teaching, 2 hours prep time 15 hours of total additional training

Position Summary: The PMP Teacher will supervise in the planning and execution of the Photos and Me Program curriculum, to targeted English Language Learners (ELL). The PMP curriculum utilizes photography, technology, and storytelling to foster higher order reading skills for students who speak a language other than English.

Responsibilities:

- Attend mandatory training of PMP Curriculum led by Teacher's College faculty.
- Participate in scheduled follow up training and coaching sessions.
- Create and execute weekly lesson plans in accordance with the approved PMP curriculum to 20 to 25 children over a 12-week cycle.
- Prepare student work between sessions when necessary (i.e. printing of photos).
- Use Spanish and English to best attend the needs of the children and families when necessary.
- Collaborate in the overall planning and execution of the PMP curriculum at the school site.
- Identify and utilize community resources to enrich the educational content of the children's program.
- Maintain good working relationships and objective attitudes with parents, trainers, teacher aide, program coordinator and other program staff.
- Assist with student assessment and the evaluation process in partnership with Teachers College and Metis Associates.
- Attend and participate in program meetings with Literacy Programs Director as needed.
- Ensure confidentiality of all information regarding children and parents.
- Additional duties as assigned by the Literacy Programs Director and Director of Youth Services.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree required; Master's Degree preferred
- NY State Teaching Certification required
- Two years experience working with pre-school and/or elementary age children preferred.
- Successful Department of Investigation and State Central Registry clearances required.
- Child Abuse and Maltreatment training certification and Infectious Disease Control training certification required.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred
- A dedicated work ethic.
- Excellent organizational ability and interpersonal skills.
- Good computer skills and writing ability.
- Demonstrated ability to perform multiple tasks effectively in a fast-paced, challenging, and constantly changing environment.
- A strong desire to help improve the lives of the residents in the East Harlem community.
