### **Position Summary:**

The Operations Manager is responsible for the daily operation of the SETP located at Gaylord White Community Center, Washington Houses Community Center & Jefferson Community Center including, but not limited to training, evaluating, and the supervising of program staff. The Operations Manager will also be responsible for program enhancement and managing relations with key Youth Services staff, program partners, and community based organizations to ensure program needs are met. Additional duties include completing weekly and monthly reports, monitoring petty cash, as well as representing the program and agency during off site meetings, conferences, and establishing relationships with agencies in the communities of the programs participants.

# **Responsibilities:**

- Collaborate with the Associate Director of Intervention/Prevention Programs for Youth and SETP staff on intervention for participants to ensure a safe environment, while also participating in workshops, trips, and activities.
- Work with SETP staff to maintain the summer schedule.
- Gather program attendance sheets and data collection as needed for reporting purposes.
- Fulfillment of other responsibilities as assigned by the Associate Director of Intervention/Prevention Programs for Youth and the Director of Youth Services.
