#### **Position Summary:**

The Naturally Occurring Retirement Community (NORC) Social Worker is responsible for providing supportive counseling and geriatric care management services to residents age 60+ of the Franklin Plaza Apartments in East Harlem.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Provide care management services to NORC participants via home and office visits.
- Conduct comprehensive needs assessments and develop and implement care plans based on identified needs.
- Conduct regular follow-up to ensure that participants' needs are being met.
- Meet with family members, caregivers, and others who play a key role in the participants' lives as dictated by the care plan.
- Provide short-term case assistance as indicated.
- Meet contractual obligations related to service units of case management and case assistance.
- Identify appropriate resources to respond to participant needs and make any referrals necessary to implement care plans.
- Provide follow-up with clients and collateral contacts as indicated.
- Input data into the DFTA database and maintain comprehensive electronic and paper case files, including intakes, care plans, case progress notes, event participation, and units of service provided, as well as any important documents.
- Assist at special events for NORC participants, such as parties, concerts, and trips.
- Facilitate and lead a support group for NORC participants.
- Conduct outreach to potential participants via telephone contact and other means. Inform Franklin Plaza residents about NORC activities and connect residents with NORC activities.

# **Qualifications:**

- LMSW required.
- Demonstrated experience with aging populations preferred.
- Demonstrated experience with working as a member of an interdisciplinary team.
- Excellent organizational, verbal, written, and interpersonal skills.
- Strong problem solving skills.
