#### **Position Summary:**

Under the supervision of the Director of Workforce Development, the Sanitation Associate performs street cleaning of several business district corridors located in East Harlem.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Clean sidewalks from the building or property line to the curb and eighteen (18) inches into the street from the curb and gutters, as well as fifty (50) feet in on every cross street along the route.
- Remove filled garbage bags from the trash receptacles replacing them with new liners.
- Clean out debris from cracks in sidewalks and tree pits.
- In the event of snow, clearing pedestrian crossings at street intersections and clearing sidewalks to such that 2 people can safely walk down.
- On occasion, work with interns assisting with the street cleaning process.
- Meet with the Director of Workforce Development.
- Manage program interns while onsite.
- Additional duties as assigned by the Director of Workforce Development.

- High School Diploma or GED.
- Minimum 2 years of sanitation or maintenance experience.
- A dedicated work ethic.
- Excellent organizational ability and interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrated ability to perform multiple tasks effectively in a fast-paced, challenging, and constantly changing environment.
